

Brass Reducer / Connectors / Adaptors

Reducers are usually concentric, eccentric reducers are used as needed to maintain the top- or bottom-of-pipe level. An adapter is generally a fitting which interfaces two dissimilar parts. The term commonly refers to: any fitting that connects pipes of different materials.

Features

- Solid Heavy-Duty Brass Construction - Corrosion and Rust resistant also reduces wear and tear that can result in premature failure.
- Best used with brass, steel or iron pipes for moving water, oil, air, natural gas and liquefied petroleum products.
